

Pine Rivers Neighbourhood Centre...Sonja from the Pine



United Nations Report

At the Commission on the Status of Women, United Nations Deputy Secretary-General Asha-Rose Migiro noted that many countries have achieved gains in various areas, including education and the development of national laws, policy and programmes, thanks in no small part to the efforts of women's groups and networks around the world.

In addition, she also noted that women still outnumber men among the world's poorest people, and that two-thirds of illiterate adults are women - a statistic that has not changed in 20 years.

"We have also seen limited reproductive progress on health. Maternal mortality remains unacceptably high. Almost all these deaths could be prevented.... So, while we have seen advances in the past 15 years, we have not seen enough....We need to move from commitment to action."



Press Release 2nd July 2010:

The UN General Assembly are moving to bring together four distinct parts of the United Nations system devoted to women's issues into one composite entity "UN Women" - expected to be operational by January 2011.

The women's movement of the UN had suffered at times from inadequate funding as well as fragmentation, owing to the lack of a single driver on women's issues. The decision to unite these areas had taken more than four years to negotiate, and had been unanimously agreed at an informal meeting of the

General Assembly on 30 June.

The new body was designed to be stronger than the sum of its four parts –

- UNIFEM
- The Division for the Advancement of Women
- The International Research and Training Institute for the Advancement of Women (INSTRAW) and
- The Office of the Special Adviser on Gender Issues & Advancement of Women.

Member States are hopeful that the appointment of a "visionary and active head" and a new executive board would add to the strength of "UN Women" attracting greater funds once formally announced. Many States had been frustrated at the lack of funding for UNIFEM, which had constrained its response to the many requests for its assistance.

It will be interesting to follow the outcome of this amalgamation and any repercussions for UNIFEM and it's associated women's organisations such as Zonta.
